## DART SAILABILITY DART SIDE QUAY SITE SAFETY

Dartside Quay is a new location for Dart Sailability. Members should take special care on the site, particularly while getting used to our new surroundings.

- Dartside Quay is a working boat yard with a number of small industrial units. There is a significant amount of traffic on site.
  - Members must use marked walkways and watch out for traffic
  - Members should not wander around exploring the site
- Marina User Vehicles do park by our club house.
  - Members must take particular care when approaching and leaving the club house in case vehicles come round the corner.
- The Toilets are in a Boat Park and Car Parking Area
  - Members must beware of cars and boats when proceeding to and from the toilets
- The large slipway to the left of the pontoon is often used for the launch and recovery of boats.
  - The area above the left-hand slipway must be kept clear at all times. Members should congregate by the Shore Party table and on the beach area beyond the slipway.
  - Members must take care when crossing this area to reach our assembly area.

- The OOD will advise of any known planned boat movements and plan our activities to keep clear of them.
- The pontoon is narrow and there is limited space on our pontoon at the end.
  - Members should not go on to the pontoon until called forward to board a boat. Only one boat at a time will board from the pontoon.
  - $\circ\,$  Only one wheelchair at a time on the pontoon
  - No wheel chairs or other equipment to be left on the pontoon. Wheel chairs and other equipment will be tagged to identify the boat being used by the owner so that they can be ready when the owner returns
  - Members must not go on the pontoon when Marina staff are working on the pontoon
- The old quay side to the left of the main slipway is rough and the edges are crumbling,
  - Members should not use the rough area to the left of the main slipway.
- There is a short steep slope towards the disabled toilet. (This is due to be modified)
  - Members should take care on the approach to the disabled toilet
