

INCIDENT MANAGEMENT

I Require Assistance

“SAFETY SAFETY THIS IS *Boat Name* ASSISTANCE REQUIRED BY” *Boat Name*

When Safety Skipper responds define assistance required and location

Safety Skipper will direct Support Boat or Safety to respond

Another Boat Requires Assistance

“SAFETY SAFETY THIS IS *Own Boat Name* ASSISTANCE REQUIRED BY *Boat Name*”

When Safety Skipper responds identify the issue and location

Safety Skipper will direct Support Boat or Safety to respond

ADDITIONAL ASSISTANCE REQUIRED

inc Emergency Services

Includes Man Overboard

“SAILABILITY RED ALERT, SAILABILITY RED ALERT – *and describe the situation.*”

Eg “Sailability Red Alert, Sailability Red Alert, *this is Support 1, Boat Name has Man Overboard in vicinity of Owers*”

RED ALERT ISSUED

All Boats shall exercise radio silence and proceed towards the Creek.

OOD will direct boats on actions to be taken to provide assistance or maintain safety watch on other boats

Pontoon Master will coordinate return to pontoon while maintaining space for any casualty to return.

EMERGENCY SERVICES ASSISTANCE REQUIRED

Anybody spotting somebody who may need assistance from the Emergency Services Advise the OOD and Pontoon Master.

“SAILABILITY EMERGENCY, SAILABILITY EMERGENCY, THIS IS *Boat Name* AMBULANCE/LIFEBOAT REQUIRED”

The OOD shall acknowledge and request details of incident and location.

OOD issues a May Day using Channel 16 on High Power

“MAYDAY MAYDAY MAYDAY This is Dart Sailability, Dart Sailability, Dart Sailability

My position is describe eg River Dart upstream from Dittisham then Repeat position.

State Nature of Distress (eg sinking, fire, man overboard, etc.) Number of crew onboard, description of boat and type of assistance required.

Immediate Assistance is Required,

Over”

The OOD may consider that it is more appropriate to make a 999 call if it is a non-life-threatening incident or if MayDay is not acknowledged due to poor signal.

OOD Should advise on best landing point for casualty

PONTOON MASTER INCIDENT MANAGEMENT

Monitor radio on M2 and Channel 16

Make 999 call if requested by OOD

Notify MDL if Emergency Services expected and send
volunteer to the gate with key card

Manage return of boats and prepare to receive casualty

Instruct Shore Party to access Health and n.o.k details for
casualty

Manage All Incidents ashore including calling
Emergency Services
